Day 1

New York Bus Washington D.C.

We will visit Washington, D.C. Monuments, museums, and Americana characterize this historic city.

Itinerary:

New York \rightarrow Washington D.C. \rightarrow DC Sightseeing Cruise (Optional, 60 mins) \rightarrow Madame Tussauds President Gallery (Optional, 60 mins) \rightarrow U.S. Capitol (Outside visit, 20 mins) \rightarrow White House (Outside visit, 20 mins) \rightarrow Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial (40 mins)

We will also pass by: Thomas Jefferson Memorial, Washington Monument, WWII Memorial and more.

Afternoon

Madame Tussaud's President Gallery

The Washington, DC arm of this worldwide phenomenon is a sight to behold. Amazingly and sometimes early lifelike figures line the halls of this art museum in the form of celebrities and politicians both famous and infamous.

U.S. Capitol In-depth Tour

The United States Capitol is among the most symbolically important and architecturally impressive buildings in the nation. It has housed the meeting chambers of the House of Representatives and the Senate for two centuries. Enjoy a guided tour with our professional escort seeing the U.S. Capitol.

The White House

The world-famous White House in Washington, DC is the official residence of the president of the United States and the place where most of the work is done. The facade of this neoclassical mansion is a global icon.

Lincoln Memorial

This iconic American monument honors the 16th president of the United States. Abraham Lincoln was president during the American Civil War and is most famous for the Emancipation Proclamation that freed all of the slaves in the US.

DC Sightseeing Cruise

Day 2

Amish Village Bus Corning Bus Watkins Glen

In the morning, we will head north to Amish Farm. They are a group of traditionalist Christian church fellowships with Swiss Anabaptist origins. Amish are known for simple living, but reluctance to adopt many conveniences of modern technology. We will take a tour around the Amish Farm and House to learn more of their daily life. In the afternoon,

we are heading to Corning Glass Museum - in western New York-which is dedicated to the history, art, and science behind glassmaking. Next, we will visit Watkins Glen in New York State which is an amazing canyon with more than 20 waterfalls.

Itinerary:

Lancaster→ Amish Village Tour (Optional, 90 mins) → Corning Museum of Glass (Optional, 75 mins) → Watkins Glen & Finger Lake (Optional, 90mins)

Special Notes:

- 1. We charge \$15/person for bus entry permit and parking of Watkins Glen State Park. In case of rainy weather, we reserve the right to change or cancel the itinerary considering safety issues.
- 2. Watkins Glen will be closed in winter every year. Usually Watkins Glen will be open during mid/late May to October depending on weather conditions. When the glen is closed, we will not visit it.

Morning Amish Farm

This authentic Amish farm in Lancaster, PA is more than 300 years old, and educational experience for the whole family. This 25-acre farm is dedicated to teaching people about the Amish lifestyle in a fun and constructive way.

Afternoon The Corning Museum of Glass

In western New York is dedicated to the history, art, and science behind glassmaking. Its collection contains more than 45,000 objects, some of which date back millennia. Guests here will be invited to watch the Hot Glass Show which is performed by professional glass craftsman, and, will have chance to know how ancient Egyptian made the world first glass mask in 3000 years ago!

Watkins Glen State Park

Glen Creek has carved a dramatic gorge into the Watkins Glen hillside, resulting in a large, cavern-like network of rock formations. Within two miles, the glen's stream descends 400 feet past 200-foot cliffs, generating 19 waterfalls along its course. The gorge path winds over and under waterfalls and through the spray of Cavern Cascade.

Day 3

Niagara Falls (US Side)

All day

We are going to see the renowned Niagara Falls. Overlooking American Fall, the Horseshoe Fall and the Bridal Veil Fall, you will be astounded by the deafening roar of the falls. It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful.

Itinerary:

Niagara In-depth Tour (Optional, 150mins, including Old Fort Niagara + Whirlpool State
Park + IMAX Movie (U.S. side) → Niagara Jetboat (Optional, 45 mins) → Niagara
Falls → Goat Island → Cave of the Winds (Optional, 90 mins) → Maid of the Mist
(Optional, 30 mins)

Special Notes:

- 1. Jet Boat will be operated only when weather condition allows; in case of storm, snow, icy condition of the Niagara River, the boat tour will be closed for safety reasons.

 Minimum age is 4 years (minimum 40 inches tall).
- 2. Maid of the Mist will be closed in winter every year. Usually it will be open during mid/late April to October depending on weather conditions.
- 3. Cave of the Winds will be closed in winter every year. Usually it will be open during mid/late May to October depending on weather conditions. When the attraction is closed, we will not visit it.
- 4. Niagara In-Depth Tour (including Old Fort Niagara + Whirlpool State Park + IMAX Movies) is a packaged self-funded item. For the price, please refer to the self-funded list.

Niagara In-Depth Tour

This interesting and exciting tour includes two popular attractions: the magnificent natural wonder - Niagara Whirlpool State Park and the U.S. historic landmark - Old Fort Niagara. The Niagara Whirlpool's greatest depth is 125 feet. It is estimated the whirlpool formed approximately 7,500 years ago by the upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by Niagara River. Old Fort Niagara is a rich historic landmark; it spans more than 300 years. Its commanding presence on the great lake caused it to play a critical role in the French and Indian War, the American Revolution and the War of 1812. The gorgeous Lake Ontario lies behind the Fort.

Whirlpool Jet Boat Tours

Experience the Niagara River like no other way possible. The exciting boat rides take passengers on a thrilling trip down the Niagara River! This round-trip ride zooms through

the Niagara Gorge, and even takes passengers to the famous Whirlpool rapids, all of a custom-built jet boat.

Afternoon

Cave of the Winds

The Cave of the Winds on the New York side of Niagara Falls is an attraction which allows sightseers to walk right up to the base of the Bridal Veil Falls with water crashing down right on them and flowing beneath the decking.

IMAX Movie (U.S. side)

In 30 minutes, you will witness Niagara Falls incredible stories and history that would otherwise take a lifetime to experience. No Niagara Falls vacation is complete without a visit to see the Niagara Adventure Movie. This movie, tells the history of human interaction with the falls, focusing largely on the "daredevils" who have crossed, boated, and even jumped off them.

Maid of The Mist

It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful. More than 6 million cubic ft. (168,000 cubic meters) of water goes over the crest line of the falls every minute during peak daytime tourist hours. This famous Maid of the Mist ride gets passengers as close as possible to the Niagara Falls! The Maid rides right into the mists thrown up by the roaring cascade as the Niagara River tumbles over the edge of the falls.
