# Day 1

New York Bus (Summer) Watkins Glen/ (Winter) Secret Caverns

Bus Niagara Falls

Guests will be picked up in New Jersey and New York in the early morning. We will head north to Secret Caverns (winter)/Watkins Glen (summer) in upstate New York. Later, we are going to see the renowned Niagara Falls. Overlooking American Fall, the Horseshoe Fall and the Bridal Veil Fall, you will be astounded by the deafening roar of the falls. It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful.

## **Itinerary:**

(Summer Itinerary: Apply when Watkins Glen is resumed, usually during mid/late May to Oct)

New York/New Jersey → Watkins Glen & Finger Lake (Optional, 90mins ) → Niagara Falls Illumination and night view

#### **Special Notes:**

- 1. We charge \$15/person for bus entry permit and parking of Watkins Glen State Park.
- 2. We will visit Corning Museum of Glass (Optional, 75 mins) instead, in case of rainy weather considering safety issues.
- 3. The completeness of night view on certain summer evenings may be limited or not available due to late sunset time and Government regulations on driving hours.
- 4. The first night hotel might change to Toronto Area.

(Winter Itinerary: Apply when Watkins Glen is closed, usually during Nov to mid/late next May)

New York/New Jersey → Secret Caverns (Optional, 60 mins) → Niagara SkyWheel (Optional, 30 mins. Only when the time allows.) → Niagara Falls Illumination and night view

## **Special Notes:**

- 1. The caves can sometimes be inaccessible due to weather conditions in winter.
- 2. We may stay at Toronto according to the actual itinerary schedule.

#### **Watkins Glen State Park**

Glen Creek has carved a dramatic gorge into the Watkins Glen hillside, resulting in a large, cavern-like network of rock formations. Within two miles, the glen's stream descends 400 feet past 200-foot cliffs, generating 19 waterfalls along its course. The gorge path winds over and under waterfalls and through the spray of Cavern Cascade.

#### or **Secret Caverns**

A 103-step staircase with various layers of limestone deposited faithfully by the prehistoric ocean is the only way in or out. Many of the caverns in this area were formed largely during the last Ice Age about 38,000-14,000 years ago. "For thousands of years, mineral-laden water has been precipitating on the walls, ceiling, and floor of the caverns, leaving behind great deposits of golden calcite. When these deposits hang from the ceiling like icicles, they are called stalactites. When they build up from the floor, they are called stalagmites. And when you see calcite dripping down over the walls or covering the rocks, that is called flowstone." – You will have a wonderful time with all the views mentioned!

#### The Corning Museum of Glass

In western New York is dedicated to the history, art, and science behind glassmaking. Its

collection contains more than 45,000 objects, some of which date back millennia. Guests here will be invited to watch the Hot Glass Show which is performed by professional glass craftsman, and, will have chance to know how ancient Egyptian made the world first glass mask in 3000 years ago!

Soar 175-feet above Niagara Falls for the view of a lifetime! The Niagara SkyWheel gives riders a breathtaking panoramic view of this spectacular natural wonder from the vantage of climate controlled gondolas. As one of Canada's largest observation wheel, The SkyWheel towers over the Niagara Falls horizon, treating guests to unsurpassed views of the Horseshoe and American Falls, the Niagara River, Niagara Parks and other landmarks.

## Night Niagara Falls Night Tour

Get closer to America's Oldest State Park at Niagara Falls State Park! Enjoy some awe-inspiring sceneries and adventure-packed experience with us! Niagara Falls is actually not one waterfall, but three. The Niagara River flows down from Lake Erie and is divided by Goat Island. There, part of it flows to the horseshoe-shaped Canadian Falls (aptly named Horseshoe Falls), and the rest flows to the American Falls. At the American falls, the river is also split by a second small island, Luna Island, creating the third, small waterfall known as Bridal Veil Falls.

## IMAX Movie (Canada side)

In 30 minutes you will witness Niagara Falls incredible stories and history that would otherwise take a lifetime to experience. No Niagara Falls vacation is complete without a visit to see the Niagara Adventure Movie. This movie, tells the history of human interaction with the falls, focusing largely on the "daredevils" who have crossed, boated, and even

jumped off them.

## Hornblower Niagara Cruise

It's the combination of height and volume that makes Niagara Falls so beautiful. More than 6 million cubic ft. (168,000 cubic meters) of water goes over the crest line of the falls every minute during peak daytime tourist hours. This famous Hornblower Niagara ride gets passengers as close as possible to the Niagara Falls! The rides right into the mists thrown up by the roaring cascade as the Niagara River tumbles over the edge of the falls.

#### **Skylon Tower**

This observation tower on the Canadian side of Niagara Falls offers bird's eye views of the natural wonder. The tower stands 520 feet from street level and 775 feet from the bottom of the falls. Relax and enjoy your meal at the 360 degree Revolving Dining Room or the family-affordable Summit Suite Buffet Dining Room restaurant. Admission to the Ride-to-the-Top and Indoor/Outdoor Observation Decks are always free when dining.

#### **Journey Behind the Falls**

To stand at the heart of Niagara, you'll first need to descend 125 feet and explore 130-year-old tunnels through the bedrock, but you'll feel the thunderous vibration of the Horseshoe Falls long before you see them. The observation deck at the foot of this 13-storey-tall wonder will leave you breathless (and maybe a little bit wet), but don't forget the viewing portals cut straight through the rock, offering a once-in-a-lifetime view of one-fifth of the world's fresh water crashing down in front of you.

#### **CN Tower**

Toronto's CN Tower is a Canadian icon and one of the most recognizable North American buildings. Made entirely of concrete, this massive monolith was the tallest structure in the world at the time of its completion in 1976.

## Mariposa Toronto Harbour Cruise

Lake Ontario Cruises offer gorgeous views of the city of Toronto from the waters of Lake Ontario, one of the famous Great Lakes of North America. See the city of Toronto and the surrounding area in a new way!

#### Ripley's Aquarium of Canada

It holds over 16,000 fantastic aquatic animals, featuring with North America's longest underwater viewing tunnel (96 meters) which allow you to walk by the Sharks, Rough tail

Stingrays, and dangerous lagoon. Guests will be both entertained and inspired to protect the waters of the world.

#### or Casa Loma

This century-old Gothic-style house in Toronto was originally the home of financier Sir Henry Mill Pellatt. The only full-sized castle in North America and Toronto's premier historic attraction. Explore secret passageways, elaborately decorated rooms with authentic period furnishings or take in the breathtaking view of Toronto from one of the towers.

In addition to taking in the scenery, passengers on boat tours of this area can learn some of the histories of the region-- which was once home to pirates and bootleggers-- and enjoy views of some famous spots.

## or Niagara In-Depth Tour

This interesting and exciting tour includes two popular attractions: the magnificent natural wonder - Niagara Whirlpool State Park and the U.S. historic landmark - Old Fort Niagara. The Niagara Whirlpool's greatest depth is 125 feet. It is estimated the whirlpool formed approximately 7,500 years ago by the upstream erosion of the Niagara escarpment by Niagara River. Old Fort Niagara is a rich historic landmark; it spans more than 300 years. Its commanding presence on the great lake caused it to play a critical role in the French and Indian War, the American Revolution and the War of 1812. The gorgeous Lake Ontario lies behind the Fort.
